- 3) The presenters personal view and outlook regarding Systems Engineering research projects and lessons learned in the project.

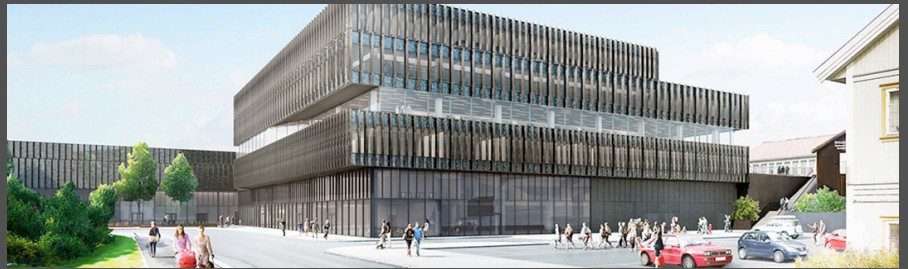
